Advanced Sewing: Couture Jacket

NOTE: The first class will start with a fitting session. Be sure to wear what you would normally wear under a jacket. You will try on your pattern (and later, your garment-in-progress).

We'll prep your pattern then fit it during the first class.

After fitting, you will sew samples, so be sure to bring your machine. We also will do a great deal of hand sewing in this class, so bring reading glasses if you need them!

DO NOT BUY OR CUT FABRIC, INTERFACING OR LINING UNTIL AFTER THE FIRST CLASS. Do not interface until we meet for the second class.

After the first class – You will buy your fabric, lining, buttons, interfacing and related entoilage. Many of the items you can purchase at Portland Sewing with your 20% student discount.

ALSO BUY OR BRING:

(All available at Portland Sewing. Please label all equipment with your name)

- Silk basting thread (Guterman size 50 or 60)
- Size 80/12 machine needles
- Beeswax
- Pin cushion or magnetic tray
- Shears—one for paper, one for cloth
- Small scissors or nippers
- Tailor's chalk
- Seam ripper
- Point turner
- Notebook and a pen or pencil
- Buttonhole punch
- Polyester all-purpose thread (Guterman or Mettler preferred) to match your project
- Hand sewing needles (Cotton darners size 7-10, Crewels or embroidery size 5-10, Betweens size 5-7)
- Fine pins with glass heads
- Tape measure
- Pinking shears
- Water soluble pen
- Tracing wheel and tracing paper
- Seam gauge
- FrayCheck
- Optional equipment:
 - Pocket template

Your instructor will suggest other items you may want to buy for use during the class or at home.
