BRING the garment you wish to copy. Please wash, dry and iron it. Put it on a hanger or fold it nicely so it is wrinkle free and as flat as possible.

BUY OR BRING: (Please label your equipment with your name)

- * Paper shears
 - * Quilter's flower head pins
 - * Awl
 - * Tailor's chalk or chalk wheel
 - * Tape measure
 - * Hera (aka "fingerpress")
 - * Sharp-pointed professional tracing wheel
 - * 2"x18" clearview ruler.
 - * Armhole, neckhole, hip and Variform curves
 - * Seam gauge
 - * Muslin as needed for prototype
- Optional: Pushpins

* = Available from Portland Sewing. Don't forget your 20% student discount!

You will copy your garment on a piece of paper to make a pattern. Use this pattern to make a prototype from muslin to check the fit. If it fits correctly, then you're ready to cut a new garment from your pattern. We will talk you through how to sew your prototype.

NOTE: You will push pins or flower head pins into the corners and seams of your existing garment.
