YOUR KIT FEE INCLUDES:

- Pattern for a man's vest

BUY:

- Fabric for vest: yards of 2½ yards of 45"-wide or 1¾ yards of 60"-wide, lightweight twill, poplin or gabardine woven (not canvas, wool, knit; no diagonals or stripes.)

NOTE: Wash and iron fabric before class to pre-shrink it.

BRING:

- Sewing machine in good working order and your machine manual and attachments
