NOTE: YOU ARE GIVEN A PATTERN FOR THIS CLASS.

The first class will start with a fitting session. If you are the client, wear fitting clothes (leotard, leggings, bike shorts) the first day of class. If you are sewing for someone else, try to bring them to class or e-mail us for other arrangements. You will have privacy for fittings.

After the fitting, you will sew samples, so be sure to bring your machine to the first class. We will talk about layout and cutting and, if we have time, begin cutting out your fabric. So bring your fabric and notions to the first class. **DO NOT CUT YOUR FABRIC** before the first class.

BUY FABRIC: You can buy fabric, lining and pocket ticking before or during the first class. For men, measure the waist to find the size. Buy the amount suggested by the pattern for that size. **TIP:** Steam wools to pre-shrink. Wash, dry and iron cottons to pre-shrink.

BRING: A sewing machine in good working order and your machine manual and attachments. Don't forget your buttonhole attachment!

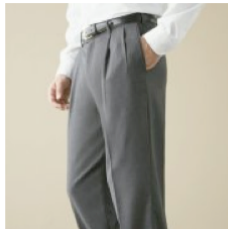

MEN'S PANTS Straight-legged pants have button waistband with carriers, side pockets, back-button pocket, front lining and fly zipper. View A is flat front. View B has front pleats.

SUGGESTED FABRICS: Suiting Wools: Gabardine. Flannel. Pant-weight Cottons: Twill, Broadcloth. Unsuitable for obvious diagonals. Allow extra fabric to match plaids or stripes. **NOTIONS:** 1/4-yard 1/4"-wide twill tape, 1 yd of 21-22"-wide knit interfacing, 1 yd of 44/45" rayon lining, 1 yd waistband curtain, 1 9" trouser zipper, all-purpose polyester thread.
