BRING:

- Sewing machine in good working order and your machine manual and attachments. Be sure you have your rolled hem and zipper foot (usually standard with most sewing machines). If you have a walking and an edgestitch foot, bring those too!

FABRIC*:

- Tulle, 8-10 yards depending on fullness and style*
- Satin, Taffeta or Silk, 1½ yards if a lining is desired*
- Satin ribbon or bias binding to bind tulle edges and seams*
- Grosgrain ribbon, 1¾ yards*
- Hook & eyes*
- Elastic*
- 1"-wide horsehair braid*

ALSO BUY OR BRING:

- Thread to match*
- Seam gauge (black metal with a plastic slide)*
- Tape measure*
- Sharps or Universal size 8 sewing machine needles
- Fine pins with glass heads, 1-3/8"*
- Pin cushion or magnetic tray*
- Shears – one for paper, a good pair for cloth*
- Small scissors or nippers*
- Chalk wheel *
- Point turner*
- Hand sewing needles: #10 sharps, #10 betweens/quilting, #10 embroidery/chenille*
- Beeswax*
- Seam ripper*
- Pen or pencil for taking notes

You will be bringing or buying other fabrics for your petticoat. We'll talk through your projects during class to determine what to buy and how much
