



QUICK POCKET WALLET

Easy to make, our Quick Pocket Wallet is loaded with pockets for your cards, coins and cash. It fits easily into a jacket or pants pocket or purse. It's a perfect yet personal holiday gift. WHAT YOU WILL NEED AT HOME:

- A fat quarter (18"x20") or 1/4 yard 45"-wide cotton fabric
- Thread to match
- 1/2" piece of 1/2"-wide velcro
- Sewing machine (with straight stitch, zigzag stitch and 3-step zigzag-optional)
- Scissors (shears and thread snips)
- Iron (with steam)
- Tape measure
- Pins & pin cushion
- Seam gauge
- Seam ripper
- Chalk pencil or blue water-soluble marker
- Point turner
- Clapper

RULES:

= right side of fabric = wrong side of fabric

SA = seam allowance; use 1/4" SA when sewing.

RST = right sides together.

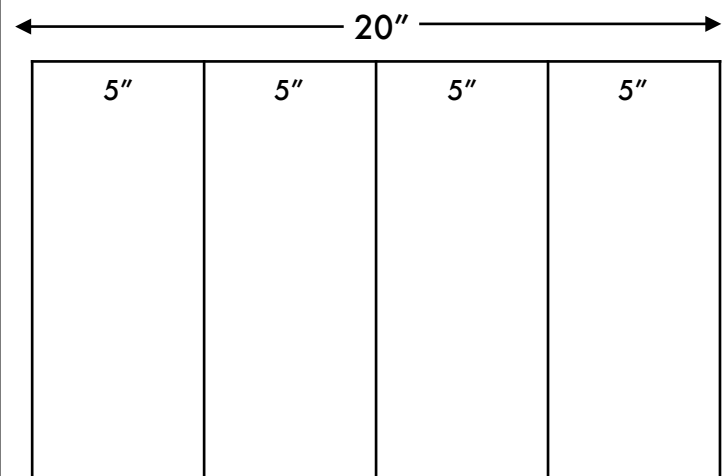
WST = wrong sides together.

Topstitch = Stitch 1/4" from edge. Use side of presser foot as guide.

Edgestitch = Stitch 1/8" from edge. Use mark on presser foot as guide.

= Check off each step as you go.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS (for fat quarter):



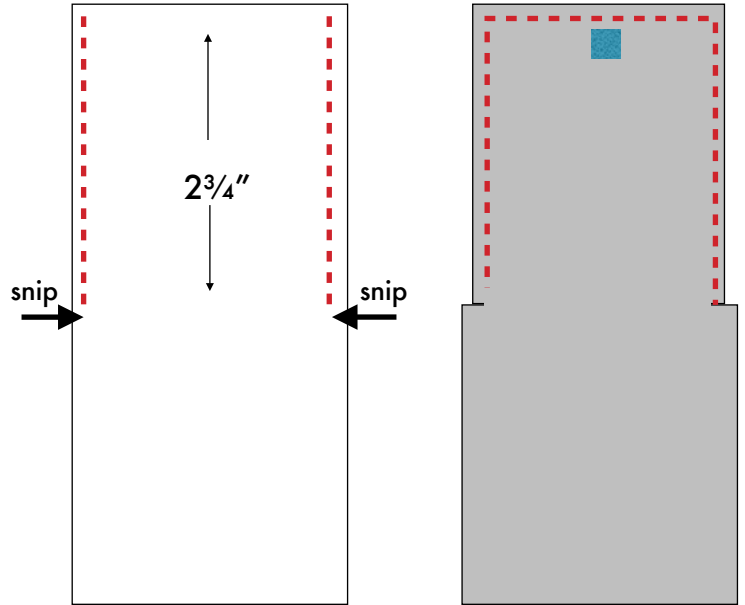
- Cut 4, 5"-wide strips from side to side.
- From one strip, cut a piece 12" (this is the cover) and a second piece 5 1/2".
- From second strip, cut two 6 1/2" pieces and one 4 1/2" piece.
- You will have left overs - enough to make another project.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS (for yardage):

ITEM	AMOUNT	SIZE
COVER	CUT ONE	12"X5"
POCKET #1	CUT ONE	4 1/2" x 5"
POCKET #2	CUT ONE	5 1/2" x 5"
POCKET #3	CUT ONE	6 1/2" x 5"
POCKET #4	CUT ONE	6 1/2" x 5"

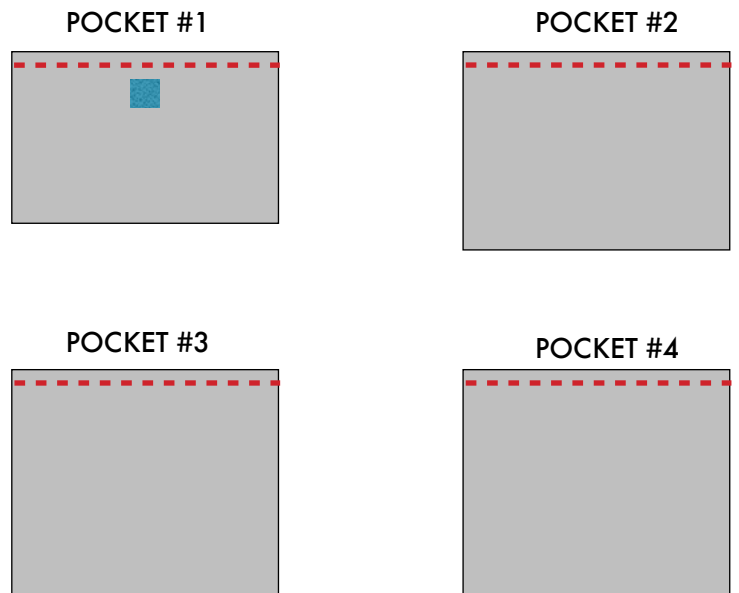
1. Cover

- Fold cover piece in half RST.
- With $\frac{1}{4}$ " SA, sew a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " seam from fold. Backstitch at both ends.
- Snip through SA at ending backstitch.
- Turn right side out. Square corners with point turner. Press flat and clap.
- Topstitch around pressed and folded edges.
- Center loop part of Velcro $\frac{1}{2}$ " from end. Edgestitch all around. Don't backstitch instead overlap beginning stitches with a couple of ending stitches. This will be inside cover of wallet.



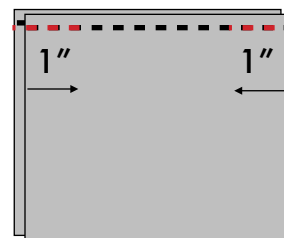
2. Pockets

- Fold each pocket in half WST so it's still 5" wide. Press.
- Topstitch folded edge of each pocket.
- Center hook part of Velcro $\frac{1}{2}$ " from stitched end of pocket #1. Edgestitch all around.



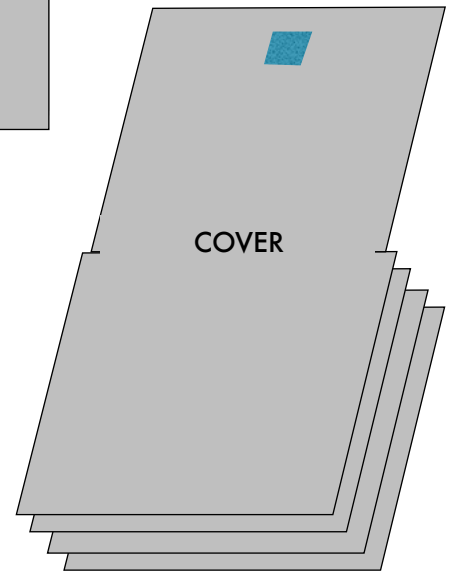
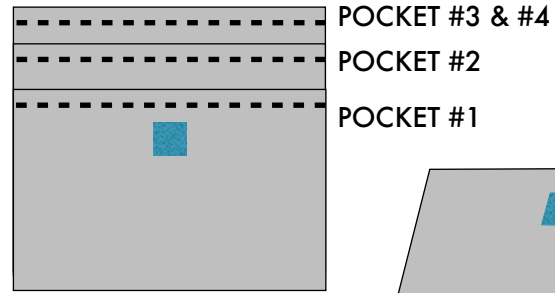
3. Coin Pocket

- Place pocket #4 on top of pocket #3. Match all edges.
- Stitch on top of previous stitchline from each side for 1". End with a double backstitch.



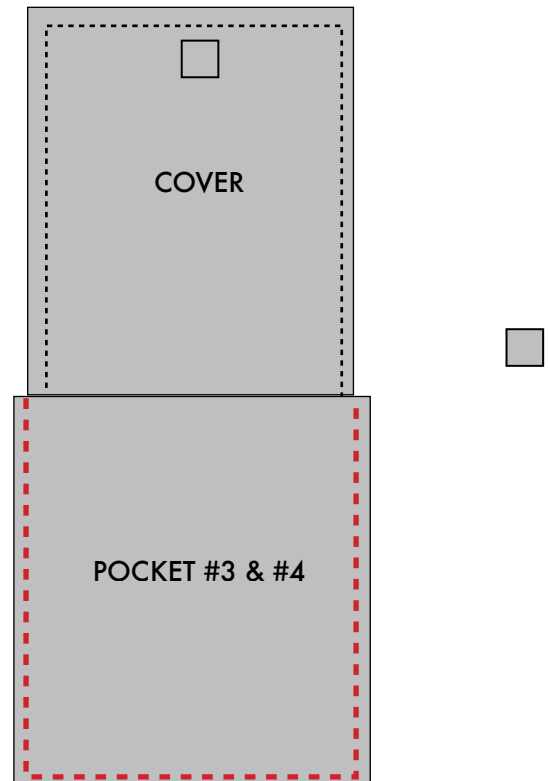
4. Assemble

- Stack pieces in this order, matching raw edges on bottom and sides:
- Pockets 3 & 4
- Pocket 2
- Pocket #1, Velcro side up
- Cover, Velcro side up.



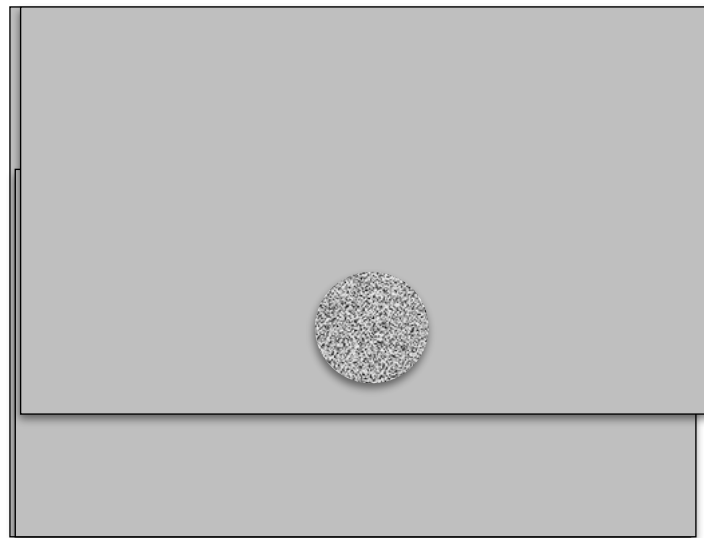
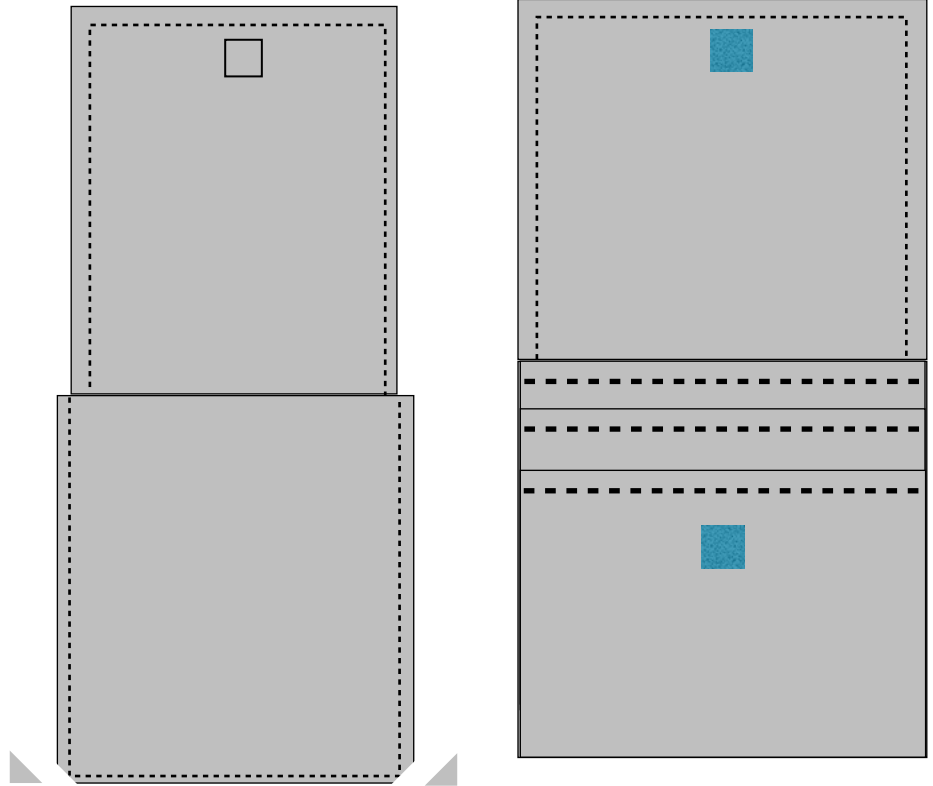
5. Sew

- Flip all layers over so pockets #3 & #4 are on top. Keep raw edges matched on bottom and sides.
- Stitch through all pocket layers on sides and bottom beginning and ending with a backstitch.
- Finish raw edges with a zigzag or 3-step zigzag.



6. Finish

- Trim corner SA .
- Reach between cover and pocket #1 to turn wallet right side out.
- Cover folds over so Velcro pieces match. Press.
- TIP: Sew a button on top of Velcro on cover to hide stitching.
