BUY:

Fabric for robe. Buy cotton or poly-cotton or lightweight flannel. Do not buy large plaids, stripes or patterns that need matching. Do not buy polar fleece or stretch fabrics. NOTE: Wash and iron fabric before class to pre-shrink it.

BRING:

- Sewing machine in good working order and your machine manual and attachments

ALSO BUY OR BRING:

- Thread to match*
- Seam gauge*
- Tape measure*
- Universal size 12 machine needles*
- Fine pins with glass heads, 1⅜”*
- Shears – one for paper, a good pair for cloth*
- Small scissors or nippers*
- Pin cushion or magnetic tray* – Point turner*
- Seam ripper*
- Pen or pencil
- Optional: Fasturn*
