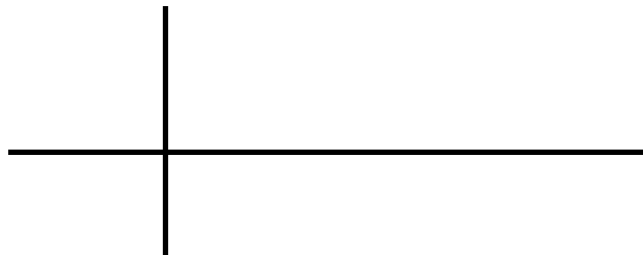
Attach to it this paper with answers to the following:
