

Supply List **Intermediate Sewing: The Classic Shirt**

NOTE: YOU ARE GIVEN A PATTERN FOR THIS CLASS. See the list of patterns and send in your choice the Saturday before class starts.

The first class will start with a fitting session. Wear a close-fitting knit top. After the fitting, you will sew samples of shirt seams, so be sure to bring your machine to the first class. We will talk about proper fabric to choose, layout and cutting. If you have fabric, bring it to the first class for discussion. **DO NOT CUT YOUR FABRIC** before the first class.

FABRIC: No need to have fabric for the first class. If you have some you like, bring it for discussion. Do not buy large plaids, stripes or patterns that are hard to match. Pre-shrink and iron fabric before cutting.

Buy sew-through buttons for the shirt; 1/2" (12 mm) is the right size*. Don't buy interfacing until after the first class*.

BRING: A sewing machine in good working order and your machine manual and attachments. Don't forget your buttonhole attachment!

- 5/8"-wide tape measure*
- Fine pins with glass heads, 1-3/8"*
- Pin cushion or magnetic tray*
- Thread to match*
- Size 10 or 12 Schmetz Universal machine needles*
- Point turner*
- Shears – one for paper, one for cloth*
- Small scissors or nippers*
- Chalk pencil or water soluble pen*
- Seam ripper*
- Seam gauge*
- Optional: Buttonhole punch*
- Optional: Pocket template*

Misses and Men's Unisex Shirt. Shirt with yoke has front button band, front patch pocket, either a Hawaiian collar, a "foolproof" collar with collarband or collarband alone, long or short sleeves and optional waist darts for closer fit.

SUGGESTED FABRICS: Cotton and cotton blends, Lightweight Denim, Crepe, Silk, Chalis, Chambray, Cotton Flannel, Rayon. Additional fabric may be needed to match stripes, plaids or one-way designs.
