NOTIONS: (*Please label all equipment with your name*)

- Pins 1" headlines stainless steel silk pins. *
- Scissors for cloth*
- Thread snips*
- 1 pkg tracing paper*
- Scissors for paper*
- 6 yards 1/8" black or red soutache
- 60" tape measure*
- Pin cushion. Wrist pin cushion preferred*
- Serrated tracing wheel (not Dritz)*
- 2, #2 pencils with handheld pencil sharpener
- C-thru ruler, 2"x18"*
- · French curves: Variform, hip, neck, armhole*
- Metal L-square

NOTE: Do not use ink pens on dress forms.

FABRIC:

- 10 yds Venus muslin*
