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BRING the article you wish to copy. Please make sure it is clean and in good shape.

**BUY OR BRING:** (Please label your equipment with your name)

- \* Paper shears
- \* Quilter's flower head pins
- \* Awl
- \* Tailor's chalk or chalk wheel
- \* Tape measure
- \* Hera (aka "fingerpress")
- \* Sharp-pointed professional tracing wheel
- \* 2"x18" clearview ruler.
- \* Armhole, neckhole, hip and Variform curves
- \* Seam gauge

Optional: Pushpins

You will copy your article on a piece of paper to make a pattern. Use this pattern to make a prototype from muslin to check the seams and size. If it is correct, then you're ready to cut a new article from your pattern. We will talk you through how to sew your prototype.

NOTE: You will use push pins or flower head pins into the corners and seams of your existing article.
