- A sewing machine in good working order plus your manual and attachments. Be sure to include a rolled hem foot.
- Thread *
- Sewing machine needles (Sharps or universal size 8) *
- Hand sewing needles (#10 sharps, #10 Between/quilting, or #10 embroidery/chenille) *
- Fine pins with glass heads *
- Pin cushion or magnetic tray *
- Tape measure *
- 18" C-thru ruler *
- Seam gauge *
- Shears – one for cloth, one for paper *
- Small scissors or nippers *
- Water soluble pen *
- Chalk wheel *
- Tracing wheel and tracing paper *
- Beeswax *
- Seam ripper *
- Silk basting thread (YLI silk thread or Gutermann size 50 or 60) *
- 7-9" regular nylon zipper *

You will be bringing/buying other fabrics for projects during the course of this class. **PLEASE WAIT** to see samples before you buy.

- 1/3 yd of Silk Crepe de Chine or Silk Charmeuse -1/3 yd of Silk Dupioni or Silk Taffeta
- 1/4 yd Silk Chiffon or Georgette
- 1/3 yd of Muslin

Not mandatory, but good items to invest in for future couture sewing:

- - Appliqué scissors (pelican shears)
- - Serrated edge shears
- - Bias tape maker (3/4")
