<u>Supply List</u> Advanced Sewing: Couture Jacket The Chanel Jacket class

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<u>NOTE</u>: The first class will start with a fitting session. Be sure to wear what you would normally wear under a jacket. You will try on your pattern (and later, your garment-in-progress).

We'll prep your pattern then fit it during the first class.

After fitting, you will sew samples, so be sure to bring your machine. We also will do a great deal of hand sewing in this class, so bring reading glasses if you need them!

DO NOT BUY OR CUT FABRIC, INTERFACING OR LINING UNTIL AFTER THE FIRST CLASS. Do not interface until we meet for the second class.

<u>After the first class</u> – You will buy your fabric, lining, buttons, interfacing and related entoilage. Many of the items you can purchase at Portland Fashion Supply with your 20% student discount.
