



BEGINNING SEWING \$135 each level (includes patterns & handouts)

Series dates Check the website for dates for individual levels. Five sessions from which to choose: Mondays, April 15-July 8, 6-9 pm OR Tuesdays, April 16-July 2, 2-5 OR 6-9 pm OR Fridays, April 19-July 12, 10 am-1 pm OR Saturdays, April 20-July 20, 10 am-1 pm Learn basic stitches, techniques and how to use your machine while making a robe (Level 2) and pjs (Level 3). Step up your skills with each level. Learn to use commercial patterns, layout and cut fabric. Prerequisite: Level 1 or private lessons

APPAREL CONSTRUCTION \$176 each level (includes patterns & handouts)

Series dates Check the website for dates for individual levels. Two sessions from which to choose:

Wednesdays, April 17-July 3, 10 am-1 pm OR 6-9 pm

Upgrade your skills. Start making clothes. Make beach pants (Level 2) and day dress or camp shirt (Level 3). Make garments fit. Unlock the secrets of interfacing. Sew buttons, buttonholes.

Prerequisite: Level 1 or private lessons

SEWING ACTIVEWEAR \$269 (includes patterns)

Fridays, May 31-July 12, 2-5 pm OR Saturdays, June 1-July 20, 2-5 pm Sew and fit high-tech stretchy fabric to make a complete ensemble, ready for action. Start with hoodies. Move on to yoga pants or leggings. Finish with a sports bra or top.

LINGERIE \$269 (includes patterns)

Fridays, May 31-July 12, 10 am-1 pm

Level 2 (Intimates). Work with knits and stretch fabrics while you make panties, a bra, bralette or a bodysuit. Attach stretch lace, plush elastic. Create garments that fit you.

WORKWEAR \$269 (includes handouts, samples)

Wednesdays, May 29-July 3, 2-5 pm

Tall, short. High bib, low bib. Cotton, corduroy or denim. Male, female, whatever — they all have lots of pockets. It's your favorite go-to garment with six styles from which to choose. All fit approved for you. Choose from overalls, coveralls or jumpsuits.

LEATHERWORKING \$289 (Includes pattern & handouts)

Mondays, June 10-July 15, 6-9 pm

Get the fundamentals of leatherworking while you make a belt and tote bag. Learn how to cut, bevel, groove and burnish edges. Wet form leather around a buckle. Learn about skiving and channeling, plus techniques for applying dyes and finishes.

SERGERY \$199 (includes patterns, handouts, sample fabrics)

Saturdays, June 1-22, 2-5 pm

Find out all your serger can do. Learn parts of a serger, how to thread and manage tensions and fix problems. Make a stitch notebook, tote bag, flatlock table runner and knit top. *Prereq: Sewing Experience*

Thursdays, May 30-July 11, 10 am-1 pm OR 6-9 pm

Here's the professional way to make patterns for personal use or to start life as a fashion designer. Pattern Basics: Take measurements and use pattern rules to make tops for dresses, shirts, blouses. Pattern Fit: Draft skirts, pants, sleeves. Unlock the mysteries of fit. Make your patterns work for you! Prerequisite: Level 1 or private lessons

PATTERN DESIGN (Pattern 3) \$359 (includes pattern paper)

Tuesdays, May 28-July 2, 10 am-1 pm

Bring in a picture or a sketch and make a pattern for that garment — just like the pros do.


