BEGINNING SEWING \$365 FOR SERIES; \$135 each level (includes patterns & handouts)

Series dates Check the website for dates for individual levels. Six sessions from which to choose: Mondays, January 6-March 24, 6-9 pm OR Tuesdays, January 7-March 25, 2-5 OR 6-9 pm OR Fridays, January 10-March 28, 10 am-1 pm OR Saturdays, January 11-March 29, 10 am-1 pm Learn basic stitches, techniques and how to use your machine while making an apron (Level 1), robe (Level 2) and pjs (Level 3). Step up your skills with each level. Learn to use commercial patterns, layout and cut fabric.

APPAREL CONSTRUCTION \$499 FOR SERIES; \$176 each level (includes patterns & handouts)

Series dates Check the website for dates for individual levels. Wednesdays, January 8-March 26, 10 am-1 pm OR 6-9 pm Upgrade your skills. Start making clothes. Make an A-line skirt or man's Henley shirt with a zipper (Level 1), beach pants (Level 2) and day dress or camp shirt (Level 3). Make garments fit. Unlock the secrets of interfacing. Sew buttons, buttonholes.

INDUSTRIAL MACHINE SEWING \$289 (includes kit)

Thursdays, January 9-February 13, 10 am-1 pm Learn how to control these fast machines then come back and use them for your projects.

KNITS \$269 or \$512 with Activewear (includes patterns)

Fridays, January 10-February 14, 2-5pm OR Saturdays, January 11-February 15, 2-5 pm Make a whole wardrobe as you learn to sew with confidence any knit from tops to dresses to cardigans and sweaters.

Choose from an over bust or under bust corset. Learn how to make multiple panels, spiral steel boning, front busk closure, waist stay, back lacing closure and bias bound edges.

Make a classic button-up. Learn to adjust patterns to fit. Then learn techniques from the garment industry for perfect cuffs, collars, collar bands and pockets. Two styles. Your choice: #4510-Man's Dress shirt, #4520-Woman's Perfect Shirt.

DRESSES \$269 or \$512 with Shirts (includes patterns)

Tuesdays, February 18-March 25, 10 am-1 pm OR 6-9 pm

Choose from one of four vintage styles to make a flattering yet comfortable dress – including the AltarPDX Aurelia. Learn about surplice, fisheye darts, bias, binding, lingerie straps, combination facings and linings – everything to make your dress your favorite go-to garment.

Use slopers to learn the basic principles of changing pattern sizes. Learn the inside secrets of increasing and decreasing sizes and government standards for grade rules.



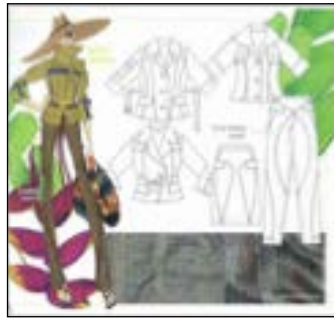

A pre-requisite for Adobe Illustrator for Fashion Design. This course introduces you to the program, the tools and the workspace. Receive practice files and templates.

ADOBE ILLUSTRATOR FOR FASHION [ONLINE] \$573

Wednesdays, January 8-March 26, 6-9 pm

It's the standard for any apparel business. See and draw garments using a computer and your Adobe program. Know Adobe like a boss.

FLATS & TECHNICAL PACKAGES [ONLINE] \$573
