BEGINNING SEWING \$377 FOR SERIES; \$140 each level (includes patterns & handouts) Series dates. Check the website for dates for individual levels. Nine sessions from which to choose: Mondays, April 7-June 23, 6-9 pm OR Tuesdays, April 8-June 24, 2-5 OR 6-9 pm OR Wednesdays, April 9-June 25, 2-5 OR 6-9 pm Fridays, April 11-June 27, 10 am-1 pm OR Saturdays, April 12-July 12, 10 am-1 pm

Learn basic stitches, techniques and how to use your machine while making an apron (Level 1), robe (Level 2) and pis (Level 3). Step up your skills with each level. Learn to use commercial patterns, layout and cut fabric.

APPAREL CONSTRUCTION \$515 FOR SERIES; \$182 each level (includes patterns & handouts)
